



Articulated Credit Conversion Form

Articulated Credit allows students to receive college credit for completing non-credit programs during high school or at a non-college non-credit granting institution. Credit will only be given for approved Articulation Agreements which define the course equivalencies. Articulation agreements are created through consultation between the academic departments and the Provost Office. Students must be matriculated before credit will be awarded. Articulated credit is not counted toward residency requirements, is not used in calculating a student's grade point average and is included in the maximum allowable transfer credit.
